Experience the inaugural Mid-Autumn Festival celebrations at Marina Bay Sands

The materials include Marina Bay Sands plastic water bottles, aluminum cans, foam blocks and old magazines.

In continuity with the integrated resort's green initiatives, Marina Bay Sands holds this competition with LaSalle students in hope to create awareness and inspire the young generation to protect the environment. Visitors will have the opportunity to vote for two of their favorite lanterns. The panel of judges in determining the third winner comprises of a representative from Marina Bay Sands, LaSalle College of the Arts and the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF). These winning pieces will be displayed on property following Mid-Autumn Festival celebrations.
