Celebrate music legends at the Marina Bay Sands Rocks Singapore festival

Guests visiting the integrated resort for the one-night only performance and free live simulcast of The Rolling Stones—14 On Fire can opt for various transportation methods

Singapore (13 March 2014) – Marina Bay Sands is all set to pump up the energy this Saturday, 15 March 2014, with the inaugural 'Marina Bay Sands Rocks Singapore' festival, an initiative by **Sands for Singapore**, the integrated resort's corporate social responsibility programme.

Beginning at 4:00pm at the outdoor Event Plaza, the 'Marina Bay Sands Rocks Singapore' festival will celebrate Singapore's local music scene with live music from popular rock acts including – *A-List, Heritage, Jive Talkin', John Molina & Krueger, and ZuluTania.*

The festival culminates with the free live simulcast of The Rolling Stones—14 On Fire concert at 8:00pm, which is being held concurrently at the Marina Bay Sands Grand Ballroom. This simulcast, which is free and open to the public, will be projected live in high definition on a giant LED screen measuring 14 metres wide. The concert will be delivered through a high power, high-quality Meyer sound system that will be suspended eight metres above the ground, providing an incredible audio visual experience for festival-goers.

Suggested modes of transportation to Marina Bay Sands

With fans and music lovers coming to Marina Bay Sands to catch a glimpse of the bands this Saturday, members of the public are advised to take public transport.

Train commuters can arrive directly at Marina Bay Sands via Bayfront MRT station (CE2, Exit B, C, D, E) along the Circle Line and Downtown Line. This brings visitors directly to the Event Plaza through The Shoppes at Marina Bay Sands.

Bus commuters can take the following bus routes serving Marina Bay Sands Hotel and the Sands Expo and Convention Centre:

The nearest **taxi** drop-off and pick-up point is at the Casino entrance, which is a 5-minute walk to the outdoor Event Plaza.

Visitors can also choose to arrive in style via a **water taxi** from Singapore River Cruise or Singapore River Explorer with docks located along popular destinations like Merlion, Esplanade, Promenade, Clifford Pier, Clarke Quay and Boat Quay.

Carpark lots at Marina Bay Sands are limited during peak hours. These lots are accessible via the South Entrance located at Sands Expo and Convention Centre, and the North Entrance accessible via Bayfront Avenue theatres and Hotel Tower 3. Valet parking is only available at Hotel Tower 1 and the Casino.

Alternatively, drivers can park at Wilson Carpark located on Bayfront Avenue, which is a 10-minute walk to The Shoppes at Marina Bay Sands.

Visitors should refrain from bringing foldable chairs or other large and bulky items. It is a free standing event open on a first-come first-serve basis. As this is a rain or shine event, the integrated resort will carry on with the performance in the event of rain. However, if there is thunder and lightning, the safety of all guests, performers and team members are paramount and Marina Bay Sands reserve the right to cancel the concert and/or simulcast for public safety reasons.
