GLOBAL ART FORUM: I AM NOT A ROBOT | SINGAPORE

Global Art Forum: I Am Not a Robot is the latest in a series of events that explore the power, paranoia and potentials of automation. Previous iterations took place at Dubai Design District in February, and at Art Dubai in March of this year. The Singapore edition is a partnership between Global Art Forum and ArtScience Museum, comprising a performance (20 Sep), a three-day conference (21–23 Sep), and a screening programme (13 Sep onwards). *I Am Not a Robot* will investigate the opportunities, complexities and trepidations of artificial intelligence, machine learning, networked systems and robotics.

The implications of automation run through our lives today and tomorrow: from algorithmic policy-making, social credit scores and gene editing. It is said that automation, more than any other factor, will fundamentally alter our working lives. We've already heard the first AI composed pop song and can read the first AI authored short story. Where does this all leave the fate of the human in a machine intelligent future? And what exactly are those machines saying about us behind our backs?

21–23 Sep

I Am Not a Robot invites audiences to reflect upon the true meaning of big data, automation and artificial intelligence in our current digital age. Through the work and ideas of artists, curators, designers, journalists, writers, scientists, technologists and filmmakers, *I Am Not a Robot* reveals how the widespread intricacies of automation are transforming our future. This three-day conference discusses Singapore's approach to AI, the future of work in an age of automation, cultural and artistic approaches to AI, big data and robotics, and depictions of robots and synthetic beings in cinema.

The main directions of his work are experimental electronic music, sound art objects and DIY electronic instruments.


SINGAPORE ECO FILM FESTIVAL
